Internet Assignment BCISL 1305/COSCL 1301 Lab

Due: June 8, 2017 – You will have several sheets of paper that you will have to turn in to me. This assignment cannot be submitted electronically. Write your name on your printouts and staple them together.

- 1. Open Microsoft Edge.
- 2. Type <u>www.learnthenet.com</u> in the address bar. Plug in your headphones or turn on your speakers.
- 3. Look at the left column of this page. Click on <u>Master the Basics</u>. On this page, click on the play arrow in the graphic titled The Internet Explained and watch the video.
- 4. After watching the video, click on <u>Surf the Web</u> in the left column.
- 5. Click on <u>♦ Web at a Glance</u> on the graphic. Start with #1 and read through each page. As you click on the right arrows at the bottom of each page, you will be completing all 20 items in this section.
- 6. In the left column, click on <u>Test Yourself</u>. Complete the <u>Net IQ Quiz</u> and then print your quiz grade by clicking on File on the menu bar, then click on PRINT, then click on OK. Pick up your printout from the printer before going any farther because it will not have your name on it. Hint: You may take the quiz as many times as necessary to get the grade you want and only print the one you want to turn in.
- 7. In the left column, click back on <u>Surf the Web</u> then click on <u>Web Browsers</u> at the top of the page. Read this section by clicking on next page at the bottom of each page.
- 8. Click back on <u>Surf the Web</u> in the left column then click on <u>How the Web Works</u> and read this section.
- 9. Click back on <u>Surf the Web</u> in the left column then click on <u>Anatomy of a Web Page</u> at the top of the page and read this section.
- 10. In the left column, click on <u>Find Information</u> then click on <u>Searching the Web</u> at the top of the page. Read this section by clicking on next page at the bottom of each page.
- 11. Click back on <u>Find Information</u> in the left column then click on <u>Online Information: Fact or</u> Fiction and read this section.
- 12. In the left column, click on <u>Stay Safe</u> then click on the <u>Computer Viruses</u> link and read all of this section.
- 13. Click back on Stay Safe in the left column then click on Passwords and read this section.
- 14. Click back on <u>Stay Safe</u> in the left column then click on <u>Safety Tips for Parents</u> and read this section.
- 15. Click back on Stay Safe in the left column then click on Online Privacy and read this section.
- 16. Click back on Stay Safe in the left column then click on Top 10 Privacy Tips and read this section.
- 17. After completing the sections above, open one of the search engines that you learned about (for example: yahoo.com, google.com, etc.) in the address bar and search for a web site that has information about the field you want to go into. Print the first page only of an article about your career choice, by clicking on File, Print, Pages and type in 1.

- 18. Using a different search engine (for example: yahoo.com, google.com, etc.) search for information on a hobby of yours and print only the first page of an article about your hobby, by clicking on File, Print, Pages, Type in 1.
- 19. Close Microsoft Edge
- 20. Staple the quiz grade from step 6 and the printouts from steps 17 and 18 together and print your name on all pages. Turn them in to receive credit for this assignment.
