# Royal Rangers

The North Texas Royal Rangers annual Pow Wow is coming up April 26-28, 2013, at The Royal Rangers Camp at Lakeview. This Pow Wow promises to be an exciting one. You, your men, and most importantly your boys in 3rd through 12th grade are invited to attend this camp. Your church does not have to have a Royal Rangers outpost to attend. Kyle Embry, along with his wife Janelle, are our district Youth Alive missionaries. Kyle will be our special guest speaker for this camp. Your boys will be challenged to "Boldly Go" where God is leading them to go in their lives as they seek to fulfill the Great Commission.

We are going to have many fun and exciting activities for your boys to participate in during the day on Saturday. More important than the fun and exciting activities, we will be having Spirit-filled services on Friday night, Saturday night, and Sunday morning. A separate registration form must be completed for each attendee. The model release form (required for any one that is 17 and younger) requires a parent or legal guardian's signature for the boy to attend Pow Wow. The leaders form (required for any one that is 18 and older) requires the pastor's signature and requires that a criminal background check has been conducted within the past two years.

Visitors are welcome at Pow Wow from 9 AM to 5 PM and are welcome to attend the evening services. Visitors to the evening services may arrive 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the service. Ladies are not allowed in the campsites at any time. All visitors must register at the security booth on Friday or the Ollie Henley Lodge on Saturday, and receive a wristband. Failure to wear wristband will result in a request to leave the premises. We respectfully request that all visitors depart as quickly as possible after visitation hours, and that they respect the boy's and men's right to privacy in their camps.

The registration fee for Pow Wow is \$77 per person. If your church is chartered for the 2012-13 charter year, you will receive a discount of 15% per person, resulting in a registration fee of \$65 per person for chartered outposts. Included in the registration fee this year is 1) a custom designed challenge coin the boys can earn by participating in the activities, 2) the patch for attending the camp, 3) a t-shirt for every attendee (for everyone to wear on Saturday of camp), and 4) all five meals (Friday supper through Sunday breakfast). It also covers insurance, activities expenses, and more.

Registration, with full payment, is due (postmarked by) April 1. Registration after that deadline will be \$15 more per person (\$92 if you are not chartered, \$80 if you are chartered).
